CW5 Rodney Weiss is the Command Chief Warrant Officer and Standardization Pilot of the United States Army Security Assistance Training Management Organization since August 2019. He enlisted in the U.S. Army as an infantryman in June 1998 and upon completing the Ranger Indoctrination Program served in 1st Ranger Battalion until December 2000.

CW5 Weiss was selected for the Warrant Officer Flight Training program and graduated Initial Entry Rotary Wing training in March 2002. He is qualified in the OH-58A/C, TH-67, Mi-17 1V/ V5, and UH-60A/L/M helicopters and is a Standardization Instructor Pilot and Instrument Examiner. He served from August 2002 thru August 2005 in C CO 2-25 Aviation Regiment of the 25th Infantry Division as an UH-60 A/L Pilot in Command and Air Mission Commander. During this time he deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. From August 2005 thru August 2008 he served with A/2-227 Aviation Regiment and A/3-227 Aviation Regiment, 1st Air Cavalry Brigade in Fort Hood, TX and supported the “Surge” in Baghdad, Iraq.

After attending the UH-60 Instructor Pilots Course and Rotary Wing Instrument Examiners Course in 2009, he served as an Instructor Pilot at Fort Rucker, AL where he taught Basic Combat Skills, Advanced Aircraft Qualification and Night Vision Goggles phase of FS XXI. In 2011 CW5 deployed to El Gora, Egypt in support of the Multinational Force and Observers as the senior Aviation advisor and Standardization Officer. He then deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Freedom Sentential in 2015 while serving as the 3-4 Assault Helicopter Battalion, 4th CAB, 4 ID Standardization Pilot from August 2012 to September 2017. While assigned to DOTD at Fort Rucker, AL CW5 Weiss deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Freedom Sentential assigned to NATO Special Operations Component Command- Afghanistan and Special Operations Joint Task Force – Afghanistan in 2019 as the Special Mission Wing/ Special Operations Advisory Group Standardization Officer.

CW5 Weiss is a graduate of the Warrant Officer Basic Course, Warrant Officer Advanced Course, Warrant Officer Intermediate Leader Education, and the Warrant Officer Senior Service Education Course. He holds a Bachelor’s of Science in Aeronautics from Embry Riddle Aeronautical University. His military awards and qualifications include the Ranger Tab, Parachutist Badge, Expert Infantryman’s Badge, Combat Action Badge, Master Aviator Badge, and Order of Saint Michael.
